

**RESOLUTION NO. 459 -2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE), FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ICE SPONSORED EL DORADO TASK FORCE WITH 77.55% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Homeland Security, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, made available an initial amount of \$30,000 in Federal funding to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ICE El Dorado Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding was accepted by Adopted Resolution No. 1143-2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Homeland Security, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, has made available a supplemental amount of \$15,000 in Federal funding to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ICE El Dorado Task Force for a total award of \$45,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the project period is October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, said funds have not been included in the 2014 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it
