**RESOLUTION NO. 426 -2014, ACCEPTING A FORFEITED  
2012 HONDA ACCORD ON BEHALF OF THE SUFFOLK  
COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE U.S. MARSHAL  
SERVICE**

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Police Department has received a forfeited 2012 Honda Accord from the U.S. Service; and

**WHEREAS**, said vehicle is to be used solely by the Suffolk County Police Department for law enforcement purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, said vehicle will replace a decommissioned vehicle and will not increase the SCPD fleet; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Police Department has recommended that said vehicle be accepted; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that said asset forfeiture of a 2012 Honda Accord, with a retail value of over five thousand dollars from the United States Service to the Suffolk County Police be and it hereby is accepted; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
