

**RESOLUTION NO. 482-2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A SUB-AWARD AGREEMENT FROM THE RESEARCH FOUNDATION FOR THE SUNY, THE PRIME RECIPIENT OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION, FOR PARTICIPATION IN A PROJECT ENTITLED "COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH: A NOVEL MULTIDISCIPLINARY, MULTI-CAMPUS UNDERGRADUATE MINOR TO ENHANCE STEM LEARNING IN ENERGY SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND POLICY" 100% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County Community College has received a sub-award agreement from The Research Foundation for The SUNY, the prime recipient of a grant award from the National Science Foundation, for participation in a project entitled "Collaborative Research: A Novel Multidisciplinary, Multi-campus Undergraduate Minor to Enhance Stem Learning in Energy, Science, Technology and Policy" in the amount of \$16,340, including indirect costs, for the period of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant sub-award will provide a multidisciplinary, multi-campus minor, with a unique regional public-private four year college and community college partnership, in energy science, technology, and policy, tailored to student and stakeholder needs and unified through online content, research opportunities, a dedicated cross-institution advisor and broad based mentoring and internship program; and

**WHEREAS**, no matching funds are required as the program is 100% reimbursed by State funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant sub-award on April 17, 2014 by Resolution No. 2014.37; and

**WHEREAS**, the College anticipates spending the \$16,340, including indirect costs, in accordance with the terms of said grant sub-award by August 31, 2014; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that said grant sub-award, in the amount of \$16,340, including \$2,145 in indirect costs, from The Research Foundation for The SUNY, the prime recipient of a grant award from the National Science Foundation, for participation in a project entitled, "Collaborative Research: A Novel Multidisciplinary, Multi-Campus Undergraduate Minor to Enhance Stem Learning in Energy Science, Technology and Policy", for the period of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014, be accepted and appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:
