RESOLUTION NO. 555 -2014, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS TO CR 13, CLINTON AVENUE/FIFTH AVENUE/CROOKED HILL ROAD (CP 5538)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction in connection with Improvements to CR 13, Crooked Hill Road from CR 7, Wicks Road to CR 106, Community College Drive; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2014 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$4,000,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, Resolution No. 202-2014 approved by the County Legislature issued a SEQRA determination of Non-Significance as the project's proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.7; the proposal does not significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and the Suffolk County Code; to the greatest extent possible, any trees removed will be replaced with wire friendly and sidewalk friendly trees and, if possible, said replacement trees will be placed on private property with permission from the landowner; and the proposed action will improve pedestrian safety, stormwater drainage and traffic congestion; therefore, the provisions of SEQRA have been complied with and no further environmental review is necessary; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty (50) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete the Improvements to CR 13, Clinton Avenue/Fifth Avenue/Crooked Hill Road, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$4,000,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
