**RESOLUTION NO. 619 -2014, ACCEPTING THE
DONATION OF A ROAD WARRIOR SPEED/LPR TRAILER
FROM NDI RECOGNITION SYSTEMS FOR USE BY THE
SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, NDI Recognition Systems wishes to donate a Road Warrior Speed/License Plate Reader trailer to the Suffolk County Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Road Warrior Speed/LPR trailer will be a useful patrol and investigative tool; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Police Department already utilizes similar equipment; and

WHEREAS, the unconditional gift comes at no additional cost to the County; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the donation of a Road Warrior Speed/LPR trailer with a value of approximately \$36,000.00 for use by the Suffolk County Police Department is hereby accepted; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
