

RESOLUTION NO. 777-2014, AMENDING THE 2014 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL 100% STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH FOR TRANSFORMED BUSINESS MODEL PROGRAMS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) is allocating additional 100% State Aid to support Transformed Business Model Programs; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds will provide for the mental health support needed by adults with severe mental illness who were previously served in sheltered workshops; as well as, other individuals from the community so they can be successful in the work environment; and

WHEREAS, Skills Unlimited, Inc. and Maryhaven Center of Hope, Inc. are currently operating these programs and have current contracts with Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, due to the growing need for employment programs for persons with mental illness it is in the best interests of the people of Suffolk County to accept and appropriate this additional 100% State Aid not currently included in the 2014 Suffolk County adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, these allocations were determined by NYS OMH and based on each agency's performance in the transition from Sheltered Workshop Programs to Transformed Business Model Programs; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept additional 100% State Aid in the amount of \$19,926 as follows:
