

**RESOLUTION NO. 778 -2014, AMENDING THE 2014
ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO REASSIGN FUNDING
FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH
FOR SINGLE POINT OF ACCESS SERVICES**

WHEREAS, State Aid Community Reinvestment funding from NYS Office of Mental Health in the amount of \$45,135 was specifically assigned to SUNY Sayville Project for their Drop-In Program; and

WHEREAS, the SUNY Sayville Project is no longer operating its Drop-In Program; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Community Mental Hygiene Services and the NYS Office of Mental Health support a transfer of this funding for the purpose of developing a Single Point of Access (SPA) housing database for residential programs in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, Family Residences and Essential Enterprises (FREE) has a current contract with Suffolk County for Single Point of Access services; and

WHEREAS, due to the growing need of housing for persons with mental illness it is in the best interests of the people of Suffolk County to amend the 2014 Operating Budget and transfer \$45,135 from SUNY Sayville Project to Family Residences and Essential Enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the reassignment of this funding maximizes the utilization of 100% State Aid; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 2014 Adopted Operating Budget is hereby amended as follows and that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to transfer the following funds:
