**RESOLUTION NO. 840 -2014, AMENDING THE 2014 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF CUSTOM FITTED BALLISTIC SOFT BODY ARMOR VESTS FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY AUXILIARY POLICE PROGRAM (CP 3517)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Fire Rescue and Emergency Services has requested funds for custom fitted ballistic soft body armor vests for the Suffolk County Auxiliary Police; and

**WHEREAS**, Auxiliary Police Officers (APO's) put their lives at risk on a daily basis and body armor vests are critical safety gear needed to protect them from serious injury or death; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are not included within the 2014 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request and pursuant to Suffolk County Charter, Section C4-13, an offsetting authorization must be provided from other capital projects; and

**WHEREAS**, amortizing the bonds over the period of probable usefulness ("PPU") of the custom fitted ballistic soft body armor vests may be fiscally beneficial as compared to including the items in the weighted average maturity ("WAM") determined for a typical bond issue; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system, implemented in the 2014 Adopted Capital Budget and Program, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$100,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5(25) and (27), in that the resolution concerns purchase of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same; as a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is determined that this program with a priority ranking of fifty-three (53) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the 2014 Adopted Capital Budget and Program be and they are hereby amended as follows:
