**RESOLUTION NO. 829 -2014, AUTHORIZING USE OF
CATHEDRAL PINES COUNTY PARK BY THE DOMINIC
TRIONFO MEMORIAL FUND FOR ITS DOM'S DAY
FUNDRAISER**

WHEREAS, The Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund is a 501(c)(3) organization with their principal place of business in Middle Island, New York; and

WHEREAS, The Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund would like to hold their Dom's Day Fundraiser at Cathedral Pines County Park; and

WHEREAS, the Dom's Day Fundraiser is scheduled to be held on Sunday, October 12, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Insurance naming Suffolk County as an additional insured has been provided by the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the use of Cathedral Pines County Park by the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund for the purpose of hosting a fundraiser on Sunday, October 12, 2014, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK STATE COUNTY LAW, subject to the receipt of a Certificate of Insurance by the County of Suffolk from the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund and the payment of the Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) event fee, and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division in the County Department of Law; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that before this event shall be permitted to occur, the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund must apply for and obtain a permit from the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation as required by Section 378-7(B) of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take such measures as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of the fundraiser at Cathedral Pines County Park by the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the Dominic Trionfo Memorial Fund shall also provide an entertainment promoter certificate to Suffolk County if it wishes to allow vendors at the event to sell tangible personal property other than food or drink and require these vendors to display such certificate in order to comply with the provisions of the NEW YORK TAX LAW; and be it further

5th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") § 617.5 (C)(15), (20) and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and

management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
