**RESOLUTION NO. -2014, EXTENDING THE LIFE OF
MASTER PLAN FOR FRANCIS S. GABRESKI AIRPORT
(CP 5738)**

WHEREAS, the Master Plan Francis S. Gabreski was given a Period of Probable Usefulness (PPU) life of five years when adopted; and

WHEREAS, it is the Department of Economic Development and Planning's intent to include a financial plan as part of the Airport Master Plan Update; and

WHEREAS, the Department has contracted with an aviation consulting firm to assist in, among other areas, the development of such financial plan; and

WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes the current Master Plan for Francis S. Gabreski PPU life to be extended from five to ten years; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Legislature approves the following PPU life be extended from five to ten years:
