

**RESOLUTION NO. 970 -2014, AMENDING THE 2014 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH CONSTRUCTION OF A HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE PLAYGROUND IN WEST SAYVILLE (CP 7157) AND RESCINDING ADOPTED RESOLUTION NOS. 79 AND 80-2011**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution Nos. 79-2011 and 80-2011 authorized the appropriation and issuance of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds, with \$50,000 for planning and \$200,000 for construction of a Skate Park in Sayville under Capital Project No. 7113; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding for the proposed Skate Park facility in Sayville has not been expended; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Suffolk County Legislature to rescind \$250,000 from Capital Project No. 7113 for Planning and Construction of a Skate Park in Sayville; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Legislature to instead create a Handicapped Accessible Playground in West Sayville in order to provide an additional recreational opportunity for children with disabilities and their families; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are not included in the 2014 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of planning and constructing said Handicapped Accessible Playground in West Sayville and pursuant to Suffolk County Charter Section C4-13, an offsetting authorization must be provided from another capital project; and

**WHEREAS**, that this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2014 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-eight (38) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the 2014 Capital Budget and Program be and is hereby amended as follows:

**6<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that Resolution Nos. 79 and 80-2011 that appropriated and authorized the funding for the Planning and Construction of a Skate Park in Sayville (CP 7113) are hereby rescinded in their entirety.
