

**RESOLUTION NO. 899-2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 FOR FY2014 PORT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (PSGP) TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, A MEMBER OF THE EAST END MARINE TASK FORCE AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY WITH 100% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Sheriff has applied for Homeland Security funding through the 2014 Port Security Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Homeland Security has awarded the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office \$25,000 in funds under the FY2014 PSGP to be administered by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the PSGP will provide funds to support sustainment and maintenance of the Sheriff's Office 41 foot regional CBRNE vessel M-41 previously purchased with FEMA funding and this vessel currently provides a regional platform for CBRNE protection, mitigation, response and recovery; and

**WHEREAS**, the PSGP funds are intended to enhance maritime domain awareness, risk management capabilities to prevent, detect, respond to and recover from terrorist attacks involving Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear (CBRN); and

**WHEREAS**, this grant is for a twenty-four (24) month period in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$25,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY2014 PSGP is slated to operate for the period beginning September 1, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, said funds have not been included in the 2014 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Executive and Sheriff are authorized to execute any agreement with the Department of Homeland Security, as necessary, to secure said grant funds; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said unbudgeted grant funds in the amount of \$25,000 as follows:
