RESOLUTION NO. 983 -2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,500 IN FEDERAL PASS -THROUGH FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK GOVERNOR’S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT’S MOTORCYCLE SAFETY ENFORCEMENT AND EDUCATION PROGRAM WITH 78% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the State of New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has awarded \$20,500 in Federal Highway Safety pass-through monies to fund a program allowing the Suffolk County Police Department to continue to conduct enforcement and education activities to effectively reduce the number of motorcycle fatalities in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the operational period for this program will be from October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2015 and

WHEREAS, said grant funds totaling \$20,500 have not been included in the 2014 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
