**RESOLUTION NO. 984 -2014, APPROVING THE TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT FOR TWO DECOMMISSIONED VEHICLES OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT FLEET THROUGH THE DONATION OF A 2008 NISSAN ALTIMA AND A 2010 NISSAN MAXIMA FROM STATE FARM INSURANCE COMPANY THROUGH 1-800-CHARITY CARS**

**WHEREAS**, State Farm Insurance Company wishes to donate a 2008 Nissan Altima and a 2010 Nissan Maxima to the Suffolk County Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, State Farm is donating the vehicles through 1-800-Charity Cars; and

**WHEREAS**, both vehicles have been approved for fleet by Suffolk County Department of Public Works; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Police Department has a need for these vehicles which will not increase the fleet, but which will replace two decommissioned vehicles, and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 255 of the Code of Suffolk County requires that no vehicles shall be purchased or leased unless "explicit approval for the acquisition of such vehicles, via lease or purchase, has been granted by the Suffolk County Legislature"; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the donation of a 2008 Nissan Altima and 2010 Nissan Maxima, each with a value over \$5,000.00, for use by the Suffolk County Police Department is hereby accepted as a temporary increase to the Police fleet.

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
