RESOLUTION NO. 894-2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A 100% REIMBURSED GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning has submitted an application for an Emergency Solutions Grant for Fiscal Year 2014 under The Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing (HEARTH) Act of 2009; and

WHEREAS, the County has been awarded an Emergency Solutions Grant in the amount of \$246,380; and

WHEREAS, \$18,478 of said funds are to be used for operational costs; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been included in the 2014 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Executive or his designee to accept the Emergency Solutions Grant and to contract with the cooperating non-profit organizations for the expenditure of these funds; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that \$18,478 of these funds be used to reimburse budgeted County expenses and that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be, and they hereby are, authorized to accept and appropriate the following funds:
