

**RESOLUTION NO. 1023 -2014, APPROPRIATING FUNDS
IN CONNECTION WITH IMPROVEMENTS TO
ENVIRONMENTAL RECHARGE BASINS (CP 5072)**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction in connection with Improvements to Environmental Recharge Basins; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2014 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$325,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that the improvements to recharge basins constitutes a Type II action pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.5(c) (1), (2), (25) in that the action involves a legislative decision concerning the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure in kind, on the same site; and purchase of materials other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-five (55) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Improvements to Environmental Recharge Basins, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$325,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
