

**RESOLUTION NO. 165 -2015, AMENDING THE 2015 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FEDERAL AND STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES TO VARIOUS CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY PROVIDERS**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (NYS OASAS) January 15, 2015 State Aid Funding Authorization has allocated additional Federal and State Aid of \$246,513 for Fiscal Year 2015 base funding to YMCA of LI Inc., Riverhead Community Awareness, Town of Smithtown/Horizons and Outreach Development Corporation to support chemical dependency and problem gambling treatment, prevention and recovery services to Suffolk County residents; and

**WHEREAS**, this additional 100% Federal and State Aid is not included in the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$246,513 in additional Federal and State Aid as follows:
