RESOLUTION NO. 183 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD INCREASE FROM THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK, FOR A WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SEA TOW SERVICES, INTERNATIONAL INC. – PHASE 2, 93% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, the 2014-2015 the College Operating Budget provides \$16,038 from The State University of New York, for a Workforce Development Training Program for Sea Tow Services, International Inc. – Phase 2, for the period of November 24, 2014 through August 11, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the grant award has been increased by \$7,192, including indirect costs, bringing the total amount of the grant award to \$23,230; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2014-2015 College Operating Budget in the amount of \$7,192, including indirect costs, to provide the increase in the grant award; and

WHEREAS, the program will provide staff with on-site courses in teamwork, leadership and management skills training that will create a professional and positive environment for advancement and effective change for the employees of Sea Tow Services, International Inc.; and

WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$1,782 are provided by Sea Tow Services, International Inc.; and

WHEREAS, matching funds in an additional amount of \$538 will be provided by Sea Tow Services, International Inc. will increase the total to \$25,550, including indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant on January 15, 2015 by Resolution No. 2015.10; and

WHEREAS, the College anticipates spending the increase in the grant award in the amount of \$7,192, including indirect costs, in accordance with the terms of said grant award before August 11, 2015; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that said 2014-2015 College Budget be amended to reflect the grant award increase, in the amount of \$7,192 including \$700 in indirect costs, from The State University of New York, for a Workforce Development Training Program for Sea Tow Services, International Inc. – Phase 2 be accepted; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, the cash match increase from Sea Tow Services, International Inc. in the amount of \$538 be accepted for the operation of the Workforce Development Training Program for Sea Tow Services, International Inc. – Phase 2; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that said grant program increase, in the amount of \$7,730, including \$700 in indirect costs, be appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:
