

**RESOLUTION NO. 178 -2015, A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING
THE APPOINTMENT OF BARRY PAUL AS THE SUFFOLK
COUNTY TREASURER**

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Treasurer Angie M. Carpenter has resigned from her elected position of County Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, Section C15-3 A of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER provides that if the Office of the County Treasurer becomes vacant other than by expiration of the term, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term at the first general election at which the vacancy may be filled; and

WHEREAS, Section C15-3 B of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER further provides that until the vacancy in the Office of the County Treasurer is filled at the next general election, the County Executive shall appoint a qualified person, with the approval of the County Legislature, to fill such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, Steven Bellone, the County Executive of Suffolk County, has appointed Barry Paul, who currently resides in Patchogue, New York, to serve as the Suffolk County Treasurer pursuant to Section C15-3 B of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the appointment of Barry Paul currently residing in Patchogue, New York, as the Suffolk County Treasurer, is hereby approved, pursuant to Section C15-3 B of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, such appointment to be effective until the vacancy in the Office of the Suffolk County Treasurer can be filled by election as provided by Section C15-3 A of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 (c)(20) and (27) as the proposal involves the adoption of regulations, policies, procedures, and local legislative decisions in connection with routine or continuing agency administration and management; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
