

**RESOLUTION NO. 302 -2015 AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION
OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF
BROOKHAVEN**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 542-2009 authorized the County Executive to enter into an Agreement with the Town of Brookhaven whereby the Town would commence eminent domain proceedings and for Suffolk County to provide financial assistance and funding in connection with the Demolition of the Old Plaza Theater in East Patchogue; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of demolition was \$725,000, of which \$350,000 will be paid by the County to the Town of Brookhaven and reimbursed to the County upon the sale of the property or by June 30, 2014 whichever was sooner; and

WHEREAS, the financial support from Suffolk County totaled \$267,506.64; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookhaven via Resolution No. 2015-0090 has asked the County for an extension to this Agreement as they have faced delays with the eminent domain process and the subsequent marketing and sale of the property; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, this Legislature approves the extension as requested to June 30, 2016; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the documents necessary with regards to this extension; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), and/or (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) AND WITHIN THE MEANING OF Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management, and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution
