**RESOLUTION NO. 481 -2015, AUTHORIZING 2015 CULTURAL
TOURISM FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the Adopted 2015 Operating Budget provides \$270,658 from Fund 192-6414 for support of cultural programs and activities relevant to the continuation and enhancement of the tourism industry; and

WHEREAS, the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts has met and recommends the 2015 funding be awarded as detailed on Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Community Re-Grant Program will be administered by the Suffolk County Alliance of Arts Councils, comprised of the Babylon Citizens Council on the Arts, Brookhaven Arts and Humanities Council, East End Arts Council, Greater Port Jefferson-Northern Brookhaven Arts Council, Huntington Arts Council, Islip Arts Council, and Patchogue Arts Council; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Suffolk County Legislature hereby approves the allocation of funding in the amount of \$270,658 for the organizations as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, and that such funding to be paid at the commencement of the pertinent contract, with the exception of the Destination Downtown awards; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(20)(27) as this legislative decision involves the routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. As such, this Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.

**RESOLUTION NO. 1095 -2015, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.
481-2015 CULTURAL TOURISM FUNDING**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 481-2015 approved the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts recommendations to allocate \$270,658 for Cultural Tourism programs.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 481-2015 to withdraw funding from The Cultural Arts Guild of Mastic Beach, at its request, in the amount of \$2,000, and withdraw the corresponding Administration fee to the East End Arts in the amount of \$400; and to reallocate those awards to other cultural tourism programs; and

WHEREAS, the Citizens Advisory Board for the Arts voted to reallocate the funding by amending the awards to Sol Y Sombra Spanish Dance Company and Theatre Three. Sol Y Sombra will receive an additional \$1,200, and Theatre Three will receive an additional \$1,200; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Legislature hereby approves the withdrawal of funds in the amount of \$2,400 in Cultural Tourism funding as set forth in the amended Exhibit "A" attached.

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Legislature hereby approve the award of funds in the amount of \$2,400 for \$1,200 each to Sol Y Sombra Spanish Dance Company and Theatre Three as set forth in the amended Exhibit "A" attached.

3rd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this resolution constitutes a Type II Action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(20)(27) as this legislative decision involves the routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment.
