

**RESOLUTION NO. 489 -2015, EXPANDING THE LAKE  
RONKONKOMA ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 121-2010 re-established the Lake Ronkonkoma Advisory Board (“the Board”) and the Board’s tenure was extended by Resolution No. 188-2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board should be expanded to include the fire departments and civic associations that serve the Lake Ronkonkoma area; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the 1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED clause of Resolution No. 121-2010, as amended by Resolution No. 188-2014, is amended to read as follows:

**1st RESOLVED**, that the Lake Ronkonkoma Advisory Board is hereby re-established and shall consist of the following members:

- 1.) The County Executive, or his designee;
- 2.) The County Legislator representing the 4<sup>th</sup> Legislative District, or designee;
- 3.) The County Legislator representing the 10<sup>th</sup> Legislative District, or designee;
- 4.) The County Legislator representing the 12<sup>th</sup> Legislative District, or designee;
- 5.) A representative from the Town of Brookhaven, to be appointed by the Town;
- 6.) A representative from the Town of Islip, to be appointed by the Town;
- 7.) A representative from the Town of Smithtown, to be appointed by the Town;
- 8.) The Assembly and Senate representatives, or their designees, of the Districts in which Lake Ronkonkoma and the adjoining watershed are physically located, for a total four (4) members;
- 9.) A representative of the Lake Ronkonkoma Civic Organization;
- 10.) A representative of the Chamber of Commerce of the Greater Ronkonkoma’s;
- 11.) A representative from the Village of Lake Grove;
- 12.) A representative from the Nesconset Sachem Civic Association;
- 13.) A representative from the Nesconset Chamber of Commerce;
- 14.) A representative from the Nesconset Taxpayers Association; [and]
- 15.) A representative from the Walter S. Commerdinger, Jr. County Park Preservative Society[.];
- 16.) A representative from the Ronkonkoma Civic Association;
- 17.) A representative from the Ronkonkoma Fire Department;
- 18.) A representative from the Lakeland Fire Department; and
- 19.) A representative from the Nesconset Fire Department;

and be it further

**2nd**           **RESOLVED**, that all other terms of Resolution No. 121-2010, as amended by Resolution No. 188-2014, shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

**3rd**           **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
