**RESOLUTION NO. 562 -2015, APPOINT MEMBER TO THE
SUFFOLK COUNTY ANIMAL AND PET ADVISORY BOARD
(DONALD STERLING)**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 22-2015 established the Suffolk County Animal and Pet Advisory Board, consisting of seven (7) members; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that Donald Sterling, founder of the Quail Run Kennel and a former member of the Suffolk County Police Department Canine Section, is hereby appointed as a member of the Suffolk County Animal and Pet Advisory Board as the resident of Suffolk County with intimate knowledge of the pet industry, for a two-year term of office to commence on the effective date of this resolution; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
