

**RESOLUTION NO. 576 -2015, APPROPRIATING FUNDS
IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF CUSTOM FITTED
BALLISTIC SOFT BODY ARMOR VESTS FOR THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT (CP 3153)**

WHEREAS, there is a mandated wear policy for the vests in the police department, and as over time vests lose their protective capability, they need to be replaced when they have outlived their useful life; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are not included within the 2015 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under Capital Project 3153; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system, implemented in the 2015 Adopted Capital Budget and Program, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, amortizing the bonds over the period of probable usefulness ("PPU") of the soft body armor vests may be fiscally beneficial as compared to including the items in the weighted average maturity ("WAM") determined for a typical bond issue; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$421,600 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5(25) and (27), in that the resolution concerns purchase of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same; as a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is determined that this program with a priority ranking of fifty-three (53) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that if it is determined to be fiscally beneficial, the soft body armor vests will be financed utilizing the PPU of the vests; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$421,600 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
