

RESOLUTION NO. 567 -2015, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1204-2014 IN CONNECTION WITH THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES COUNTYWIDE (CP 1817)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds appropriated in Resolution No. 1204-2014 be modified to include funds for furniture and equipment; and

WHEREAS, this project will include all ancillary capital costs associated with construction, furniture, demountable partitions, equipment and modification improvements (including restacking) to the H. Lee Dennison building, including costs associated with moving various County departments and modifying those locations; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the \$800,000 in construction funds appropriated in Resolution No. 1204-2014, be amended to \$400,000 construction and \$400,000 in furniture and equipment; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 1st Resolved Clause of Resolution No. 1204-2014 is hereby amended as follows:

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (2) (25), of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the resolution concerns replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire code and in that the resolution concerns purchase of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the 5th Resolved Clause of Resolution No. 1204-2014 is hereby amended as follows:

5th RESOLVED, that the proceeds of the \$800,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and are hereby appropriated as follows:

3rd **RESOLVED**, that all ancillary capital costs are included in (and support of) this capital project; including, but not limited to, expenses such as modifying and renovation to existing County buildings, moving expenses and its related costs; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 (C) (20) and (27) as the proposal involves the adoption of regulations, policies, procedures, and local legislative decisions in connection with routine or continuing agency administration and management.
