**RESOLUTION NO. 522 -2015, TRANSFERRING 100%
GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000 AWARDED BY
THE US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO THE SUFFOLK
COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE
DEPARTMENT, SUFFOLK COUNTY PROBATION
DEPARTMENT AND DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, Suffolk County applied for and was awarded a grant through the United States Department of Justice's Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Local Solicitation Grant Program bearing award number 2013-DJ-BX-0783, in the amount of \$180,104; and

WHEREAS, the GRANT funds were accepted in accordance with Resolution No. 894-2013 dated October 8, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department has a balance of \$20,000 remaining in 001-PRO-3199-4980-JRV1 in the 2015 funds. This project was not implemented to date and as such the funds will not be expended by the Mental Health Association; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department has a balance of \$15,000 remaining in 001-PRO-3199-4980-JQV1 in the 2015 funds. This project was not implemented to date and as such these funds will not be expended by Stony Brook Psychiatric Associates; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Probation has received approval from the U.S. Department of Justice to amend the grant application to transfer \$35,000 of grant funds to the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office, Suffolk County Departments of Probation and Police and District Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office will use the additional \$8,750 to support the G.R.E.A.T. program; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's office will use the additional \$8,750 to support the Detective Investigator for the Heroin Task Force;

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Police Department will use the additional \$8,610 to purchase body worn undercover camera systems; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Probation Department will use the additional funds to purchase Samsung Galaxy tablets and accessories for Probation Officers; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to transfer the program funds in the amount of \$35,000 from the Department of Probation as follows:

4th **RESOLVED**, that nothing contained herein shall be construed as obligating or committing the County of Suffolk to continue the employment of the individuals filling the positions created by this Resolution at the conclusion of the grant funding provided for such position created by said grant.
