

**RESOLUTION NO. 714 -2015, AUTHORIZING THE  
TRANSFER OF A LANDSCAPING UTILITY TRAILER TO THE  
LONG ISLAND NATIVE PLANT INITIATIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the Long Island Native Plant Initiative received a Fund 477 water quality grant in 2013 which was administered by the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation; and

**WHEREAS**, a landscaping utility trailer was budgeted through this grant for use by the Long Island Native Plant Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation purchased the trailer in February, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the trailer is surplus to the needs of the County and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation supports transferring ownership of the landscaping utility trailer to the Long Island Native Plant Initiative, a not-for-profit organization; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, a utility trailer with trailer specifications "Homesteader 612CS with 3500# axel, 6'1" tall", presently in the possession of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby declared surplus to the needs of the County; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the transfer of the above described landscaping utility trailer to the Long Island Native Plant Initiative, P.O. Box 1279, Hampton Bays, New York 11946 is hereby approved; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
