**RESOLUTION NO. 884 -2015, ACCEPTING 100% STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PASS-THROUGH THE FOUNDATION FOR AIDS RESEARCH (amfAR) TO SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE REGIONAL OPIOID OVERDOSE REVERSAL EFFORTS**

**WHEREAS**, these 100% State grant funds pass-through amfAR to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services are for Regional Opioid Overdose Reversal Efforts and the award amount is \$15,000 for the period 7/01/2015-6/30/2016; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds are a reimbursement to support first responders conducting opioid overdose prevention and reversal activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the expenses related to providing these services are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, these 100% State grant funds were not included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and need to be accepted; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept \$15,000 in grant funds as follows:
