**RESOLUTION NO. 999 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR HIV REPORTING AND PARTNER NOTIFICATION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Department of Health has awarded 100% State grant funds to the Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health for HIV Reporting and Partner Notification Program in the amount of \$284,836 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding is used to maintain patient and partner notification service information for the Partnership Surveillance and Partner Service Program in an effort to reduce the spread of HIV; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of these grant funds, salaries and fringe, were included in the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget and the remaining funds need to be appropriated; now, therefore be it
