

RESOLUTION NO. 1001 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE US CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, 100% Federal grant funds have been awarded through the New York State Department of Health for the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program-CRI in the amount of \$570,709 for the period 07/01/15-06/30/16; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds will be used for public health emergency preparedness with a focus on planning and assessment, surveillance, health alert notifications, risk communication, and education and training; and

WHEREAS, a portion of these grant funds are already included in the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget and \$198,909 needs to be appropriated; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$198,909 in additional grant funds as follows:
