RESOLUTION NO. 1003 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE US ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE BEACH ACT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, 100% Federal grant funds passed through the New York State Department of Health have been awarded to the Department of Health Services, Division of Environmental Quality for the Beach Act Program in the amount of \$104,705 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

WHEREAS, this program will monitor recreational waters for the purpose of protecting bathers from potential exposure to pathogenic organisms through sample collection; and

WHEREAS, a portion of these funds were already included in the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget and \$60,633 needs to be appropriated; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$60,633 in Federal grant funds as follows:
