**RESOLUTION NO. 1006 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, these 100% Federal grant funds are passed through the New York State Department of Health to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services for the Children with Special Health Care Needs Program and the award amount is \$112,774 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

**WHEREAS**, this program provides community outreach, education, and referrals to providers and families of children with special health care needs age birth to twenty-one years; and

**WHEREAS**, this program also identifies gaps and barriers in the health service systems and proposes strategies to address them; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of these funds are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and \$66,726 needs to be appropriated; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds are 100% federally funded; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>ST</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$66,726 in grant funds as follows:
