RESOLUTION NO. 1053 -2015, ACCEPTING A DONATION OF TWENTY TO TWENTY-FOUR (20-24) BIKE LOCKERS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, New York State Department of Transportation approached Suffolk County to donate twenty to twenty-four (20-24) unused bike lockers; and

WHEREAS, the provision of bike lockers at various transit and county facilities would advance some of the recommendations in the County's 2015 Comprehensive Plan to promote non-motorized mobility; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County would accept the donation of the bike lockers and administer a bike locker rental program according to the terms of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation wishes to donate twenty to twenty-four (20-24) bike lockers with a value of \$18,300.00 to \$21,960.00; and

WHEREAS, the unconditional gift comes with additional costs to the County to administer the program; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said donation; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
