RESOLUTION NO. 1064 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION TO SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE STATE POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (SPDES) WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANNING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation has awarded 100% Federal grant funds to the Department of Health Services for the SPDES Water Quality Management Planning Program in the amount of \$149,225 for the period 04/01/15-03/31/16; and

WHEREAS, this program provides inspections and water sampling data; and

WHEREAS, the expenses related to performing these inspections and samplings are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the revenues were not included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and needs to be accepted; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept \$37,306 in funds as follows:
