**RESOLUTION NO. 1065 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL AND STATE GRANT FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN (WIC) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, these 100% Federal and State grant funds are passed through the New York State Department of Health to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services for the WIC Program and the award amount is \$3,779,034 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the WIC Program is to improve the nutrition and health status of income eligible pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants and preschool children up to five (5) years of age; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of these funds are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and \$412,211 needs to be appropriated; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds are 100% Federal and State funded; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>ST</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$412,211 in grant funds as follows:
