RESOLUTION NO. 1066 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION FOR WATER QUALITY MONITORING FOR PESTICIDES IN NASSAU AND SUFFOLK COUNTIES

WHEREAS, 100% State grant funds from the New York State Department of Environmental Quality have been awarded to the Department of Health Services for Water Quality Monitoring for Pesticides in Nassau and Suffolk Counties in the amount of \$300,000 for the period 04/01/15-03/31/16; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds reimburse monitoring performed on specific land uses, including golf courses, vineyards, greenhouses, nurseries, row crop farming and sod farms; and

WHEREAS, off-shore impacts to sea grass and other ecological effects from pesticide use will also be investigated; and

WHEREAS, the expenses related to providing these services are already included in the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the revenue for this grant needs to be appropriated to the 2015 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$75,000 in State grant funds as follows:
