RESOLUTION NO. 1067 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE EARLY INTERVENTION ADMINISTRATION AND CHILD FIND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, these 100% Federal grant funds passed through the New York State Department of Health to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services are for the Early Intervention (EI) Administration and Child Find Program and the award amount is \$700,481 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

WHEREAS, this program is to refer children who are at risk for or suspected to have developmental delays to the EI Program; and

WHEREAS, a portion of these funds are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and \$525,361 needs to be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, these funds are 100% federally funded; now, therefore be it

1ST RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$525,361 in grant funds as follows:
