RESOLUTION NO. 1069 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE MATERNAL AND INFANT COMMUNITY HEALTH COLLABORATIVE (MICHC)

WHEREAS, these 100% Federal grant funds passed through the New York State Department of Health to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services are for the MICHC and the award amount is \$435,937 for the period 10/01/15-09/30/16; and

WHEREAS, this program is to improve and provide education to service providers, community groups, and partners, develop strategies and activities to promote positive healthy changes on an individual, organizational and community level; and

WHEREAS, a portion of these funds are already included in the 2015 Suffolk County Adopted Operating Budget and \$299,309 needs to be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, these funds are 100% State funded; now, therefore be it

1ST RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$299,309 in grant funds as follows:
