RESOLUTION NO. 1060 -2015, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A SUBCONTRACT AWARD FROM COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER, THE PRIME INSTITUTION OF A GRANT AWARD FUNDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL COORDINATOR (HHS/ONC), FOR PARTICIPATION IN A PROJECT ENTITLED "COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY WORKFORCE TRAINING TO EDUCATE HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS", 100% REIMBURSED BY FEDERAL FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, Columbia University Medical Center is in receipt of a grant award funded by the Department of Health and Human Services Office of the National Coordinator (HHS/ONC) to carry out a project entitled "ONC Workforce Training"; and

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Community College has been selected to receive a subcontract award from Columbia University Medical Center, for participation in a program entitled "Columbia University Workforce Training To Educate Healthcare Professionals" in the amount of \$72,482, including indirect costs, for the period of June 29, 2015 through June 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, through this Information Technology program, Suffolk County Community College will provide education and online training opportunities for 500 participants drawn from all levels of health professionals through this establishment of medical health informatics education, while promoting the effective utilization of health Information Technology systems; and

WHEREAS, matching funds are not required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant subcontract award on October 29, 2015 by Resolution No. 2015.72; and

WHEREAS, the College anticipates spending the \$72,482, including indirect costs, in accordance with the terms of said grant sub-award by June 28, 2017; now therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that said grant subcontract award, in the amount of \$72,482, including \$6,347 in indirect costs, from Columbia University Medical Center, the prime institution of a grant award funded by the Department of Health and Human Services Office of the National Coordinator (HHS/ONC), for participation in a project entitled, "Columbia University Workforce Training to Educate Healthcare Professionals", for the period of June 29, 2015 through June 28, 2017, be accepted and appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:
