RESOLUTION NO. 1096 -2015, ACCEPTING \$10,000 FROM THE TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH SUFFOLK COUNTY'S MILITARY BASE RETENTION GRANT FROM NEW YORK STATE EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT (NYSESD) FOR GABRESKI AIRPORT

WHEREAS, Suffolk County applied for and was awarded a grant under the NYSESD Military Base Retention Grant Program in 2012 to safeguard the future of the Air National Guard (ANG) base at Gabreski Airport; and

WHEREAS, NYSESD Military Base Retention Grant Program is designed to enhance the competitiveness of the base during federal base realignments and closures (BRAC) expected in future defense budget cuts,

WHEREAS, the Town of Southampton contributed to the County's grant application by committing \$10,000 for costs associated with a successful grant application that would in turn provide support to the 106th Rescue Wing stationed at Gabreski Airport; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept said Town of Southampton funds as follows:

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this Resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5 (c) (20) and (27), in that the law authorizes routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. Since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
