

**RESOLUTION NO. 1109 -2015, AMENDING THE HOURLY RATE FOR TEMPORARY POSITIONS IN THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the State of New York has adopted legislation to increase the minimum wage from the current \$8.75 per hour to \$9.00 per hour effective on December 31, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Temporary Classification and Salary Plan contains provisions whereby hourly rates require adjustment based on the New York State legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2015 and 2016 Adopted Operating Budgets include adequate appropriations to fund the changes required by the New York State legislation; now, therefore be it
