

RESOLUTION NO. 53 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO RE-ALLOCATE 100% STATE AID FROM THE JEWISH BOARD OF FAMILY AND CHILDREN'S SERVICES TO HANDS ACROSS LONG ISLAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING A PEER OPERATED WELLNESS AND RECOVERY CENTER

WHEREAS, The Jewish Board of Family and Children's Services (JBFCFS) will cease operation of its former "LIFE" Programs listed below on 1/31/16; and

WHEREAS, these services support adults with serious mental illness in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, Hands Across Long Island (HALI) has been deemed the successful responder to RFP 15038 for Peer-Operated Wellness and Recovery Center Services; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in executing a contract amendment which consolidates various JBFCFS programs with Hands Across Long Island to ensure the continuation of services; and

WHEREAS, funding is currently included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget for JBFCFS and needs to be re-allocated to HALI; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to transfer \$664,021 in State Aid as follows:
