

RESOLUTION NO. 61 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH TO FAMILY SERVICE LEAGUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING CARE COORDINATION AND INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health has issued additional State Aid in the amount of \$557,527 for an expansion of community services by the development of a new program; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds are to be used to develop Care Coordination and Intensive Case Management Services for children in Suffolk County with the purpose of empowering children and their families, reducing wait lists for case management services and reducing hospitalizations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health Services issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for "Care Coordination and Intensive Case Management Services" for its Division of Community Mental Hygiene Services; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Division of the Department of Public Works advertised for these services and Family Service League was the successful proposer to RFP 15034 and was deemed to be a qualified contractor; and

WHEREAS, this additional 100% State Aid is not currently included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$557,527 in additional State Aid as follows:
