

**RESOLUTION NO. 117 -2016, AUTHORIZING USE OF INDIAN ISLAND COUNTY PARK BY NORTH FORK ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL, INC., FOR A 5K EARTH DAY WALK/RUN FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, North Fork Environmental Council, Inc., would like to use the Indian Island County Park for the purpose of hosting a 5K Earth Day walk/run fundraising event; and

**WHEREAS**, the 5K Earth Day walk/run will be held on Sunday, April 24, 2016 at Indian Island County Park from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Insurance naming Suffolk County as an additional insured has been provided by North Fork Environmental Council, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Suffolk shall receive consideration in the total amount of Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$750.00), payment of which shall be guaranteed by North Fork Environmental Council, Inc.; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the use of County-owned property, i.e., the Indian Island County Park in Riverhead, in consideration of the payment of Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$750.00), for the purpose of conducting a 5K Earth Day walk/run fundraiser on Sunday, April 24, 2016, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK COUNTY LAW, subject to the County's receipt of a Certificate of Insurance naming the County of Suffolk as an additional insured from North Fork Environmental Council, Inc., and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division in the County Department of Law; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER and Section 643-7 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE to issue a permit to North Fork Environmental Council, Inc. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation and the County Department of Public Works are further authorized, empowered and directed to take such measures, either alone or in conjunction with each other, as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of a 5K Earth Day walk/run fundraiser for North Fork Environmental Council, Inc.; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that North Fork Environmental Council, Inc. shall also provide an entertainment promoter certificate to Suffolk County if it wishes to allow vendors at the event to sell tangible personal property other than food or drink and require these vendors to display such certificate in order to comply with the provisions of the NEW YORK TAX LAW; and be it further

**4th RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") §617.5(c)(15), (20), and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no

permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and, since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
