

RESOLUTION NO. 62 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH TO FEDERATION OF ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENHANCING THE CHILDREN AND YOUTH SINGLE POINT OF ACCESS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health has issued additional 100% State Aid for the expansion of Single Point of Access Services (SPOA) for Children and Youth; and

WHEREAS, these services support children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbances in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds are not currently included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$134,252 in additional State Aid as follows:
