RESOLUTION NO. 65 -2016, AMENDING THE 2016 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO RE-ALLOCATE 100% STATE AID FROM THE JEWISH BOARD OF FAMILY AND CHILDREN'S SERVICES TO FAMILY SERVICE LEAGUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING A HEALTH HOME PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Jewish Board of Family and Children's Services (JBFCS) will cease operation of its Health Home Program on 1/31/16; and

WHEREAS, these services support adults with serious mental illness in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) supports the transfer of this program to Family Service League; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in executing a contract amendment with Family Service League to ensure the continuation of these services; and

WHEREAS, funding is currently included in the 2016 Adopted Operating Budget for JBFCS and needs to be transferred to Family Service League; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$375,375 in State Aid as follows:
