

RESOLUTION NO. 131 -2016, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF THE JAIL TIME AND ACCRUAL SYSTEM (CP 3065)

WHEREAS, the of Suffolk County has requested funds for Capital Project 3065 for the planning of the Replacement Jail Time and Accrual System; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Office Jail Time and Accrual System is very old and in need of replacement very soon; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under Capital Program Number 3065; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2016 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, amortizing the bonds over the period of probable usefulness (“PPU”) of the purchase of the replacement jail time and accrual system may be fiscally beneficial as compared to and include the items in the weighted average maturity (“WAM”) determined for a typical bond issue; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$20,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations (“NYCRR”), in that the law authorizes information collection, including basic data collection and research, routine agency administration and management and preliminary planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action; since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-six (56), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that if it is determined to be fiscally beneficial, the replacement jail time and accrual system will be financed utilizing the PPU of the system; and be it further

4th RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$20,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
