

RESOLUTION NO. 110 -2016, AMENDING THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY PLAN IN CONNECTION WITH A GRADE CHANGE FOR THE TITLE OF DIRECTOR OF OPTICAL IMAGING IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the County Clerk has requested a grade change for the position of Director of Optical Imaging currently in the Clerk's operating budget; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the County Clerk's Office to cover the cost; and

WHEREAS, this title is unique to the County and therefore no other positions are affected; and

WHEREAS, the position of Director of Optical Imaging is a fifty percent (50%) salary and one-third (1/3) fringe benefits reimbursed position through the New York State Mortgage Tax Reimbursement program. In 2016, the Clerk's Office has received \$2.5 million in reimbursements for the collection of mortgage taxes; and

WHEREAS, state and local mandates placed on this office during recent years have greatly increased the need for in-house high-tech technical support. The County has realized substantial savings by having these functions performed in-house as opposed to expending funds for external consulting and contractual services; and

WHEREAS, the new grade change more accurately reflects the managerial responsibilities and technical expertise required for this position; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Classification and Salary Plan be proposed to be amended to include a grade change for the following title with effective date as follows:
