

**RESOLUTION NO. 149 -2016, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ACCELERATED TRANSIT CAPITAL (ATC) FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC PARATRANSIT VEHICLES AND AMENDING THE 2016 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM (CP 5658)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds to purchase public transit vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of New York State, in his SFY 2015-16 Budget, has included Accelerated Transit Capital (ATC) funds to maintain Downstate Suburban and Upstate Public Transportation systems across the state; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County has been awarded \$1,488,296 in ATC funds by New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT); and

**WHEREAS**, no local match is required for the receipt of these funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County must “first instance fund” the purchase; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system of capital projects as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds have not been included within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (“NYCRR”) Section 617.5 (25) and (27), in that the resolution concerns purchasing of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive materials, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same; as a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-six (36) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the Purchasing Division is authorized to acquire paratransit vans and related equipment, and including pre and post-delivery Buy America audits and inspection during manufacture subject to approvals of FTA and NYSDOT and pursuant to applicable federal and state regulations; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the 2016 Capital Budget and Program be and they are hereby amended as follows:
