

**RESOLUTION NO. 196 -2016, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH BEACH REPLENISHMENT AT MESCHUTT COUNTY PARK (CP 7163)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Parks has requested funds for beach replenishment at Meschutt County Park; and

**WHEREAS**, this program will provide for the transport and deposit of sand by truck along the shoreline, to protect the park's facilities and infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2016 Capital Budget and Program to cover the construction cost under Capital Project 7163; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2016 Capital Budget as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, amortizing the bonds over the period of probable usefulness ("PPU") in connection with beach replenishment at Meschutt County Park may be fiscally beneficial as compared to including the items in the weighted average maturity ("WAM") determined for a typical bond issue; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$50,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 (C), (2), "replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes, unless such action meets or exceeds any thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part"; and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-two (32), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that if it is determined to be fiscally beneficial, beach replenishment at Meschutt County Park will be financed utilizing the PPU of the equipment; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$50,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and are hereby appropriated as follows:
